The Faculty Boards have decided to exempt from the ILC foreign language exams those students who have been in possession of the following qualifications **for no more than three years for PE I/II and second languages and no more than two years for PE III/ IV:**

It should also be noted that:

- those who have followed and completed (in Italy or abroad) a high school education at an English-speaking school, are exempt from the **Professional English I/II/III** exams.
- students are exempt from the **second language** exams if they have a high school diploma that is equivalent to the Italian qualification obtained in the country where the language is the official language or obtained at an institute whose language of instruction corresponds to the chosen language.
