



HOW TO SUBMIT THE STUDY PLAN

Master's Degree Courses – academic year 2022/2023

The study plan must be completed on your personal page in the Online Services, in the section "SCELTA INSEGNAMENTI" (Choice of courses)

- **from 11 October to 21 November 2022**
- **from 1 to 15 March 2023**

by students who are **regularly enrolled and up to date with fee payments for the academic year 2022/23**.

In order to avoid timetable clashes, it is advisable to choose from the recommended options for your course and year (and your specific curriculum, for some Master's degree courses). It is also recommended that you check the course timetable before making your choice.

Under no circumstances will requests for compiling the study plan be accepted that are submitted

- outside the windows for online compilation
- during examination sessions

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPILING THE STUDY PLAN

- **First-year** students must compile their study plan and enter **OPTIONAL** courses up to a maximum of 18 CFUs on the dates set for the academic year 2022/23. Optional courses can be selected not only from your own course programme (preferred solution), but also from other Master's degree courses, activated on any year of the course.



Students enrolled in the first year of the Master's degree courses in

- HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT
- ART, VALORIZATION STRATEGIES AND MARKETS

do not have to compile the study plan for the first year of the course.

- **second-year** students must compile their study plan up to a maximum of 18 CFUs on the dates set for the academic year 2022/23. Optional courses can be selected not only from your own course programme (preferred solution), but also from other Master's degree courses, activated on any year of the course.

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN MASTER'S DEGREE COURSES HELD IN ENGLISH

Students enrolled in Master's degree courses held in English must include optional courses preferably held in English.

International students enrolled in Master's degree courses held in English must pass the course in ITALIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE as an extra-curricular activity by the time they submit their degree application.

Students on the Master's degree course in HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT must fulfil the requirements of a second foreign language (in addition to English) as an extra-curricular activity by the time they submit their degree application.

STUDENTS 'FUORI CORSO'

Students enrolling as 'fuori corso' for the academic year 2022/23 and who need to change their study plan must be duly enrolled for the academic year 2022/23 and consequently pay the 'fuori corso' enrolment fee.

First year 'fuori corso': it is possible to enter up to 18 CFUs from the optional courses activated for the academic year 2022/23.

From the second year 'fuori corso': students must be regularly enrolled for the academic year 2022/23. For requests for modifications please write to pianodistudio@iulm.it
