

## ENROLLMENT IN THE ENTRANCE TEST FOR DEGREE COURSES AND PRE-ENROLMENT IN THE MASTER'S DEGREE COURSE

Policy for the Processing of personal data collected from the person  
concerned art. 13 of EU Reg. 2016/679 – GDPR

If you are a minor, before communicating your data to the University, please read the information carefully together with your parents or whoever takes their place, as well as ask your parents or whoever exercises parental responsibility to express, by means of flags, consent to the processing of your personal data of a particular nature for the purpose B) referred to in point 2 of the information. ### 1. DATA PROCESSORS

The DATA CONTROLLER pursuant to articles 4 and 24 of EU Reg. 2016/679 is the International University of languages and Media IULM, with headquarters in Via Carlo Bo 1 - 20143 Milan, in the person of its pro-tempore legal representative.

The University, in accordance with art. 37-39 Reg. UE 2016/679, appointed Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at the following email address: [dpo.iulm@dpoprofessionalservice.it](mailto:dpo.iulm@dpoprofessionalservice.it).

### 2. PURPOSE AND LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

Personal data shall be processed lawfully, in compliance with the provisions of art. 6 of EU Reg. 2016/679, for the following purposes:

#### pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, lett. b)

- allow verification of access requirements;
- allow the carrying out of admission tests to limited number degree courses and the tests for the evaluation of initial preparation, where required, and the related administrative activities;
- allow the pre-enrollment in a Master, the carrying out of the relative admission interviews and the related administrative activities;

#### pursuant to art. 6 lett. e) and art. 9 par. 2 lett. g)

- identify suitable tools to facilitate the carrying out of the selection test in case of disability or in the presence of specific learning disorders;
- allow students with disabilities (pursuant to Law 104/1992) or with specific learning disorders to take the test with additional time and compensatory measures.

The personal data of Data Subject and the results obtained in the tests may also be subject, in anonymized form, to processing also for statistical or scientific research purposes or to identify actions aimed at improving educational services.

### 3. DATA RECIPIENTS OR RECIPIENT CATEGORIES

The supplied personal data may be transferred to the recipients mentioned in art. 28 and in art. 29 of EU Reg. 2016/679, who shall process them in the capacity of data processors and/or as individuals operating under the authority of the Controller and Processor, in order to comply with the relevant contracts or purposes. More specifically, data may be transferred to recipients in the following categories:

- internal structures of the University, in charge of managing student enrollment and careers, services that deal with defining actions aimed at improving quality and teaching;
- entities carrying out maintenance on the information system and the data collection platform;
- any external companies entrusted with the management of the tests;
- embassies or consulates (in relation to any visa issued).

Subjects belonging to the abovementioned categories shall become Data Processors, or shall operate in a completely autonomous way, as Data Controllers in their own right. The list of designated Data Processors is constantly updated and is available at the offices of IULM University.

#### **4. DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES AND/OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS**

Personal data will not be transferred abroad within or outside the European Union.

#### **5. STORAGE PERIOD OR CRITERIA**

Data shall be processed automatically and/or manually, in a manner and with tools that ensure maximum security and confidentiality, by specifically appointed subjects.

In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 paragraph 1 letter. e) of EU Reg. 2016/679 the personal data provided as well as those contained in the rankings may be kept for historical interest indefinitely over time, on the basis of criteria that can be consulted within the guidelines provided by the CODAU (Association formed by the General Directors of Italian university administrations).

#### **6. PROVISION AND REFUSAL OF PERSONAL DATA**

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in point 2 of this information document is necessary to manage the activities described above related to the selection of students through the entry test. Failure to provide personal data will make it impossible to operate all the activities referred to in point 2 of this information.

#### **7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS**

You shall be able to exercise your rights under articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679 by writing to the Data Controller, the Data processor or the Data Protection Officer at the following address: [privacy@iulm.it](mailto:privacy@iulm.it)

You shall have the right to obtain, at any moment, from the Controller, access to your personal data, and their rectification, you may request the cancellation of mere contact data. If you have registered for the test but did not show up, you can also request the cancellation of your personal data.

Moreover, you have the right to object to the processing of your data (including automated processing, such as, for instance, profiling) and to receive the personal data concerning you. Without prejudice for any other administrative and jurisdictional recourse, if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of EU Reg. 2016/679, you have the right, pursuant to art. 15 letter f) of said EU Reg. 2016/679, to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority and, pursuant to art. 6 paragraph 1 letter a) and to art. 9 paragraph 2 letter a), to revoke your consent to the processing at any time.

In case of a request for data portability, the Data Controller shall provide your personal data to you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, without prejudice for the provisions of paragraphs 3 and 4 of art. 20 of EU Reg. 2016/679.
