- Every slide in the unit gets saved by the platform system, so that the student can interrupt work on the course at any time and resume from where they left.

It's a pressure all too familiar for Imperial College PhD student Serge Emerge, 26, as he **gears up** for the launch of his smart watch brand Blocks along with co-founders Omer El Fakir, 27, **a fellow PhD student** at Imperial, and graduate Alireza Tahmasebzadeh, 21.

In case of <u>didactic problems</u>, by clicking on the "Tutor" button, available in all the pages of the platform, the student will be able to send an email to the teacher-tutor.







At the end of each 3 unit section there is a self-evaluation progress test.







<u>The test is not timed.</u> At the top righthand corner there is a timer with the sole purpose of allowing the student to keep track of the minutes spent in carrying out the test.





- Students can choose to follow <u>a ten- week course</u> in the first or second semester. The classroom lessons provide a fundamental opportunity for interaction with the teacher and other students in the class.
- Although <u>attendance is not compulsory</u> the classroom course can be considered an integral part of the learning process.
