

Demand for university spaces by young talents

Information on the processing of personal data collected from the data subject pursuant to Article 13 of EU Reg.2016/679 - GDPR

1. PROCESSING SUBJECTS

The **DATA CONTROLLER** pursuant to articles 4 and 24 of EU Reg. 2016/679 is the International University of languages and Media IULM, with headquarters in Via Carlo Bo 1 - 20143 Milan, in the person of its protempore legal representative.

The University, in accordance with art. 37-39 Reg. UE 2016/679, appointed Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at the following email address: <u>dpo.iulm@dpoprofessionalservice.it</u>.

2. PURPOSE AND LAWFULNESS OF THE PROCESSING

Personal data shall be processed lawfully, in compliance with the provisions of art. 6 of EU Reg. 2016/679, for the following purposes:

- A. pursuant to art. 6, par. 1, letter b) <u>sending the application for the presentation of an artistic and/or cultural</u> <u>project to be carried out in the spaces of the University</u> and management of the related administrative and organizational activities;
- B. pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter a) <u>subject to consent and until your objection, sending promotional</u> <u>communications</u>, via e-mail (newsletter, mailing list), relating to the educational offer and events and initiatives promoted by the IULM University.

3. DATA RECIPIENTS OR RECIPIENT CATEGORIES

The supplied personal data may be transferred to the recipients mentioned in art. 28 and in art. 29 of EU Reg. 2016/679, who shall process them in the capacity of data processors and/or as individuals operating under the authority of the Controller and Processor, in order to comply with the relevant contracts or purposes. More specifically, data may be transferred to recipients in the following categories:

- entities carrying out maintenance on the information system and the data collection platform;

- authorized persons within the Data Controller organization.

Subjects belonging to the abovementioned categories shall become the Data Processors, or shall operate in a completely autonomous way, as Data Controllers in their own right. The list of designated Data Processors is constantly updated and is available at the IULM University.

4. DATA TRANSFER TO A THIRD COUNTRY AND/OR AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATION

Personal data will not be transferred abroad within or outside the European Union.

If Controller has to transfer Your data abroad, inside or outside the European Union, the transfer will be made within the limits of and in compliance with the conditions of articles 44 and ff. of EU Reg. 2016/679.

5. RETENTION PERIOD OR CRITERIA

The processing will be carried out in automated and/or manual form, with methods and tools aimed at ensuring maximum security and confidentiality, by persons specifically appointed for this purpose.

In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 paragraph 1 letter e) of EU Reg. 2016/679, the personal data collected will be stored in a form that allows the identification of the data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the personal data are processed and in any case until the withdrawal of consent for purpose B) of point 2.



6. NATURE OF PROVISION AND REFUSAL

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in point 2 lett. A) of this information document is necessary to respond to the application for the allocation of spaces. Failure to provide personal data will make it impossible to fulfill the request itself. The provision of data for the purposes referred to in point 2 letter B) (sending promotional communications) is, on the other hand, optional, however, failure to provide personal data will make it impossible to receive newsletters relating to events and initiatives of the Data Controller, without prejudice to purposes A).

7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

You shall be able to unsubscribe from le newsletter clicking on the link "cancellati dalla mailing list" (unsubscribe) in the footer of the message. You may assert your rights as expressed by Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 of EU Regulation 2016/679, by contacting the Data Controller, by writing to privacy@iulm.it, or to the Data Protection Officer pursuant to Article 38 paragraph 4, by writing to the address dpo.iulm@dpoprofessionalservice.it. You have the right, at any time, to ask the Data Controller for access to your personal data, rectification, deletion of the same, limitation of processing, as well as the portability of your data. Without prejudice to any other administrative and judicial remedy, if you believe that the processing of data concerning you violates the provisions of EU Reg. 2016/679, pursuant to art. 15 letter f) of the aforementioned EU Reg. 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data and, with reference to art. 6 (1) (a) and Art. 9 (2) (a), you have the right to revoke your consent at any time. In the event of a request for data portability, the Data Controller will provide you with the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, without prejudice to paragraphs 3 and 4 of art. 20 of EU Reg. 2016/679.
