REMOTE ACCESS TO REAL-TIME IMAGES

privacy policy pursuant to art. 13 of EU Reg. 2016/679.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

Pursuant to articles 4 and 24 of EU Reg. 2016/679, the DATA CONTROLLER is Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM, Via Carlo Bo 1 - 20143 Milan (MI), in the person of its pro tempore legal representative.

The University, in accordance with art. 37-39 Reg. UE 2016/679, appointed Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at the following email address: <u>dpo.iulm@dpoprofessionalservice.it</u>.

2. PURPOSE AND LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

Personal data shall be processed lawfully, in compliance with the provisions of art. 6, par. 1, lett. f) of EU Reg. 2016/679 in order to check remotely the presence of people at the Student Secretariat desk.

3. PROCESSING MODE - STORAGE PERIOD - DATA RECIPIENTS

The camera only allows **remote viewing of images in real time ("live") without any recording of them.** The viewing of the images taken through the camera occurs only by people specifically appointed by the Data Controller. Since the images are not registered, they cannot be disseminated or transferred abroad.

4. PROVISION AND REFUSAL OF PERSONAL DATA

The disclosure of personal data is required, as it is instrumental to the access to the Student Secretariat premises. Failure to provide said data shall prevent the Data Controller from giving you access to the above mentioned premises.

7. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

You shall be able to exercise your rights under articles 15, 17, 18, 19, 21 of EU Regulation 2016/679 by writing to the Data Controller, the Data processor or the Data Protection Officer at the following address: privacy@iulm.it.

You shall have the right to obtain, at any moment, from the controller, access to your personal data, erasure, as well as the restriction of their processing. Moreover, you have the right to object to the processing of your data. Without prejudice for any other administrative and jurisdictional recourse, if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of EU Reg. 2016/679, you have the right, pursuant to art. 15 letter f) of said EU Reg. 2016/679, to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
