The students of the MSc in Hospitality and Tourism Management can attend one semester at **University of Oulu**, Finland, obtaining a **Master of Science in Geography, Specialization on Tourism Geographies**.

Eligibility Requirements

You must be a student regularly enrolled in the first year of IULM's Master of Hospitality and tourism management.

Semester's start:

- January 2025

Language requirements:

- TOEFL 92 (with a minimum of 20 in Writing section)
- IELTS language certificate with an average score of 6.5, with no sub score lower than 5.5.

Ranking criteria:

The ranking of candidates will be determined based on the student's GPA and the number of credits acquired at the end of the second 2024 exam session. If two or more candidates have the same score, the tie-breaker will be the final undergraduate grade.

Deadline for submission of application:

- July 4th 2024

Places available:

- 3 places

Tuition fees and grants:

Each student will pay the appropriate tuition and fees to IULM University during attendance at the Host Institution.

- EU/EEA Students are waived the payment of tuition fees to the University of Oulu and can benefit from the Erasmus+ grant; please refer to the [Erasmus+ call of application](#) for details regarding art. 7 "Financial contribution to the mobility".
- Non-EU/EEA Students, according to the Finnish national regulation, are required to pay additional tuition fees to the University of Oulu. For the academic year 2023-24 the tuition fees amount to 5000 euros.

As non-EU/EEA students qualify as fee-paying students, they are not eligible for receiving the Erasmus grant nor the Fondo Sostegno Giovani MUR.

Nonetheless, non-EU/EEA Students will benefit from the IULM tuition fee reduction according to the [Regulations for University Fees and Contributions Academic Year 2024/2025](#) (2.2) which states "*students participating in a Dual Degree programme in the academic year 2024/2025, which requires the payment of tuition fees to the partner university, shall be granted a partial reduction of 50% on 2024/2025 IULM tuition fees and contributions, regardless of the contribution band allocated.*"

Visas, Permit of Stay, Supplementary Insurance:

Students who are citizens of a non-EU country must research independently and be aware in advance of the legal procedures to be completed to stay in Finland (entry visa, permit of stay, and health regulations). The Mobility Office is in no way responsible for any withdrawal due to the lack of the requirements or legal documents to be able to stay in Finland.

Insurance Coverage:

Basic health insurance coverage is supplied by the Italian National Health Service also during a stay in another European Union country through the European Health Insurance Card EHIC (conditions and benefits at: <https://ec.europa.eu/social/main.jsp?catId=559&langId=en>).

However, European Health Insurance Card coverage may be insufficient, especially in the event of repatriation and/or medical surgery. Students are therefore strongly encouraged to take out supplementary private health insurance.

The student benefits from civil liability and accident insurance coverage during the stay abroad, limited to the period of academic activities and in compliance with the legal and administrative provisions of the home and host countries. The University has signed Civil Liability insurance with QBE EUROPE SA/NV Company: policy no. 074 0000026 and Accident Insurance with GENERALI Italia Company (formerly INA Assitalia) - policy no. 360029587 – Master Policy 350036808.

If additional forms of insurance are needed due to the requirements of the host university, national legislation, or personal needs, students are required to make their arrangements. Participants are directly responsible for taking out any additional insurance coverage.

Application Form:

The terms and conditions of the online application are published in the Community. Students will have to log in with their credentials in the STUDENT AREA of the 'Servizi di Segreteria online' of IULM University.
