- **CONSIDERING** the definitive Form for Periodic Accreditation of Universities and Courses of Study (AVA3), version approved by the ANVUR Governing Council on 8 September 2022;
- **CONSIDERING** the ANVUR document "Guidelines for the Quality Assurance System in Universities" approved by Governing Council Resolution no. 26 of 13 February 2023;
- **CONSIDERING** the Guidelines for the implementation of the University's QA System issued on 2 February 2016, as amended;
- **CONSIDERING** the findings expressed by ANVUR in the Final Periodic Accreditation Report on the University and the Programmes regarding the participation of students in the bodies of the University Quality Assurance System approved by the ANVUR Governing Board on 8 March 2017;
- **CONSIDERING** the Statute of Autonomy of IULM University (Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM), published in the Gazzetta Ufficiale della Repubblica Italiana no. 59 on 12 March 1998, as amended;
- **CONSIDERING** the University's Academic Regulations, issued by Rector's Decree no. 11738 on 18 September 2001, as amended;

#### **CONSIDERING** the electoral regulations, issued by Rector's Decree no. 12700 on 22 September 2003, as amended, and in particular article 25;

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- **CONSIDERING** the decisions taken by the Academic Senate in their meetings on 14 June 2016, 21 March 2017, and 4 April 2018;
- **CONSIDERING** Rector's Decree no. 20472 of 5 December 2023 approving the proceedings for the voting and counting operations relating to the elections of student representatives for the two-year period 2023/2024 2024/2025;
- **CONSIDERING** Rector's Decree no. 20759 of 21 June 2024 appointing the Joint Teaching-Student Committees for the academic biennium 2024/2026;
- **CONSIDERING** the call for applications for participation in Joint Teaching-Student Committees issued by Rector's Decree no. 20669 of 23 April 2024, for the two-year period 2024/2025 with a deadline for submitting applications on 10 May 2024 and the subsequent reopening with Rector's Decree no. 20793 of 19 July 2024;
- **CONSIDERING** that for the positions advertised for participation of students in the activities of the Joint Teaching-Student Committees:
  - no applications were received for the Courses in Corporate Communication and Public Relations *curriculum Corporate communication and public relations (in English)* and in *Television, Cinema and New Media*;
  - Master's degree course in *Art, Valorization Strategies and the Markets* the elected student, registered with ID number 1027676 has graduated and therefore no longer holds student status;
  - in the 2024/25 academic year, the new Master's Degree in *Fashion Communication and Luxury Strategies (in English)* was established and for the Master's Degree in Marketing, consumi e comunicazione, the new study path in *Marketing, Consumer Behavior and Communication (in English)* for which it is necessary to identify the student component of the Joint Teacher-Student Commission;
- **CONSIDERING** the need to ensure the presence of one student from each course of study at the University on each Joint Teaching-Student Committee;

#### DECREES

#### Art. 1 – Scope

The University's Quality Assurance System (QA) provides for the participation of students. Their main role is to collaborate in analysing data and information in order to detect critical points and formulate proposals for improvements in the study programmes.

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To this end, students are expected to participate in the Joint Teaching-Student Committees. For the period from the signing of the contract until **31 December 2025** the call for applications is for a total of **5** contracts, as described in the following table:

The students selected will become members of the **Joint Teaching-Student Committees**, with the assignment being made on the basis of the course of study in which they are enrolled.

The activities covered by this call for applications will be carried out mainly in person and, in agreement with the Chairperson of the Joint Committee, may be carried out remotely. The must have their own PC and an adequate internet connection; connection and telephone costs are not reimbursable.

Further information regarding the activities and characteristics of the duties are specified in **Annex A** of this call.

At least 5 hours of initial training on the topics of Quality and Evaluation will be provided by the *Presidio della Qualità* (the unit responsible for the internal QA system), which the selected students **are obliged to attend**. The training hours are included in the duration of the contract. Details of the main duties to be carried out will be provided during the training course, also in agreement with the student representatives.

## Art. 2 – Application procedures

Applications may be submitted by students who are regularly enrolled in Bachelor's and Master's degree courses at IULM University, by filling out the form available on the University website at www.iulm.it (in the section "Vivere in IULM – Collaborare con l'Università") and submitting on 24 March 2025 together with the relevant documentation in PDF format to: presidio.qualita@iulm.it.

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The following documents must be attached to the application:

- curriculum vitae;
- photocopy of a valid ID document.

#### Art. 3 – Selection procedure

Selection will be made on the basis of rankings determined by the scoring method described in **Annex B**. The interviews, which candidates are obliged to attend (failure to attend will result in exclusion from the rankings), will be held in **April 2025** by the Chairperson of the Joint Committee (or their delegate).

The interviews will be held online on the TEAMS platform. The dates and times of the interviews will be communicated to candidates through their IULM institutional account (@studenti.iulm.it).

This call for applications constitutes an invitation for admission to the selection interview, after verification of the requirements by the University Offices.

Applicants must be available at the institutional IULM e-mail account (@studenti.iulm.it) specified in the application, on the day and time set for the interview. For the purpose of identification and under penalty of exclusion, each candidate must, before the interview begins, identify him/herself by showing the same identity document already submitted as an attachment to the application.

The candidate may be excluded if he/she has not indicated the institutional e-mail address, if he/she is not connected, if he/she is unavailable on the day or at the time established, or if he/she does not show a valid identity document.

IULM University declines all responsibility in the event that technical reasons prevent regular procedures from being followed when carrying out the interview.

In the event of the renunciation or the exclusion of a candidate, the contract may be awarded to the first eligible candidate in the rankings (for the remaining hours).

At the end of the interviews, a final merit ranking list will be drawn up comprising the basic score and the score obtained at the interview.

#### Art. 4 – Execution of duties

Duties will be carried out **from the signing of the deed of commitment to 31 December 2025** and will cover both lesson periods and examination periods.

Students must guarantee availability regarding times in accordance with the instructions received from the Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-Student Committee, also in relation to the specific requirements of the individual degree courses.

The students selected will participate in the QA process for the courses of study and will be called upon to carry out data analyses and support activities for the preparation of documents. In addition, the students will be required to gather observations and suggestions from students following the related course of study, also through at least two annual meetings organized for sharing and exchanging ideas and/or discussions with students appointed as 'classroom spokespersons'.

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#### Art. 5 – Forfeiture

In the case of termination of student status (for example, in the event of **failure to complete enrolment**, **failure to renew enrolment for the following year**, **withdrawal from university studies**, **transfer to another university or attainment of the degree**), the contract will be terminated by the Joint Committees with the consequent obligation to notify the Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-Student Committee and the *Presidio della Qualità*.

Likewise, students are required to renounce the contract in the event of prolonged absences (e.g. **periods of study abroad** or **internships**) that do not allow them to carry out the assigned activities in a regular manner.

In the case where students obtain their 1st level degree during the mandate - only for those who graduate in the July and November sessions - and then enrol, without interrupting their studies, in one of IULM University's Master's degree courses in the academic year following the one in which they obtained their 1st level degree, after hearing the Chairperson of the Joint Committee (or their delegate) for the Joint Teaching-Student Committees, the contracts may be extended until the end of the calendar year to which they refer.

In the event of failure to perform the duties required, as verified by the *Presidio della Qualità* or the Joint Committees, the students may be relieved of their duties.

#### Art. 6 – Method of payment

The amount to be paid to students is set at € 360.00 net per year for a fixed total of 40 hours. Activation of the IULM card is required for the payment of the remuneration.

If the service is suspended and no subsequent period of service is authorised, no remuneration is due in relation to the period of collaboration not carried out.

If the collaboration starts during the year or ends prematurely, the remuneration shall be equal to the months of service actually served.

The payment will be made by the University Administration on receiving certification of the activity carried out, countersigned by the Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-Student Committee using the forms provided by the University.

Pursuant to art. 11, paragraph III, of Legislative Decree no. 68 of 29 March 2012, the service requested from the student shall be tax-exempt and does not in any way constitute a permanent employment contract.

The University, if necessary and at its own expense, will provide for insurance against accidents for the students who have been assigned the contracts. The position does not give rise to any obligation for health or pension insurance. The work will not lead to receiving any evaluation for the purposes of participation in public competitive examinations.

#### Art. 7 – Incompatibility

The awarding of the contracts referred to in this call is without prejudice to the awarding of other benefits by the Right to Study Office.

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The contracts referred to in this call are incompatible with participation in the activities of the *Presidio della Qualità*, the Independent Evaluation Unit, the Academic Senate and the Board of Governors.

The remuneration deriving from the contracts referred to in this call can be combined with the benefits referred to in art. 12, paragraph III of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001 (University scholarships and scholarships to promote special projects for international mobility for study or training purposes, also regarding preparation of the Master's degree thesis) announced by IULM University.

## **Description of duties:**

- gather observations and suggestions from the students on the course of study, also by organizing at least two annual meetings organized for sharing and exchanging ideas and/or discussions with students appointed as 'classroom spokespersons'.

## Privacy policy for processing personal data collected from the data subject pursuant to article 13 Reg. (EU) 2016/679- GDPR

## **1. DATA PROCESSORS**

The **data controller** is the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM, located in Via Carlo Bo, 1, Milan and represented by its *pro-tempore* legal representative.

# 2. DATA PROCESSED

In order to allow the interview to take place via online streaming, in addition to personal data and contact details, the candidates' image and voice will also be processed using their webcam. The image and voice will not be recorded or broadcast in any way. Candidates will be asked to

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show their identity document during streaming for the sole purpose of allowing the University to recognise them.

# **3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING AND LAWFUL BASIS**

The personal data provided will be processed in accordance with the conditions of lawful basis pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 for the following purposes:

- online interview;
- identification of the candidate;
- verification that the requirements for participation in the selection procedure are met and that there are no grounds for exclusion;
- management of the selection procedure, at all stages, including publication of results and rankings.

## 4. RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF DATA

The personal data will be communicated to the following recipients:

**Microsoft Corporation,** the autonomous data controller, which will provide the Teams platform in order to allow the connection between the candidate and the University (privacy policy available at the following link: https://privacy.microsoft.com/it-IT/privacystatement#mainnoticetoendusersmodule)

The data may also be communicated to the following recipients:

- authorised persons within the organisation of the Data Controller;
- competent authorities for the fulfilment of legal obligations, upon request;
- persons carrying out maintenance on the information system.

The subjects belonging to the above categories perform the function of authorised data processors, pursuant to article 29 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, Data Processors, or operate completely independently as separate Data Controllers. The list of designated Data Processors is constantly updated and available from the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM.

# 5. DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES AND/OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

The personal data provided will not in any way be transferred abroad either within or outside the European Union.

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#### 6. PERIOD OF DATA STORAGE OR CRITERIA

The processing of data will be carried out both automatically and manually, using methods and tools designed to ensure maximum security and confidentiality, by persons specifically appointed for this purpose.

Since the test will take place via live streaming, the images and voices of the candidates will not be recorded in any way, nor stored by the University and will not be disseminated in any way.

Personal data relating to personal details and data relating to rankings or records will be stored indefinitely, also for historical interest, in accordance with the archiving obligations laid down by current legislation (Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, Prime Ministerial Decree of 3 December 2013).

The documents containing the results and the rankings will be published on the University website for a maximum period of 3 months.

## 7. NATURE OF THE CONFERMENT AND REFUSAL

The provision of personal data for the purposes set out in point 3 of this policy document is **necessary** in order to manage the activities described above in connection with the selection process. Failure to agree to providing the personal data will make it impossible to manage all the activities referred to in point 3.

#### 8. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

You may exercise your rights in accordance with the provisions set out in articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 by contacting the Data Controller or the the Data Protection Officer at privacy@iulm.it.

You have the right at any time to ask the Data Controller for access to your personal data, and also to exercise your rights regarding rectification and deletion of your data, with the exception of those that must be retained by the University, the purpose limitation of your data, where one of the cases provided for in Article 18 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 is applicable, as well as the right to object at any time to the processing of your data, and the portability of your data.

Without prejudice to any other administrative or jurisdictional appeal, should you believe that the processing of your data violates the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, pursuant to article 15 letter f) of the aforementioned Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to make a complaint to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data.
