- CONSIDERING** Ministerial Decree no. 987 of 12 December /2016, following which ANVUR, the Italian National Agency for the Evaluation of Universities and Research Institutes, published new “Guidelines for the periodic accreditation of Universities and programmes”;
- CONSIDERING** the ANVUR Document “Self-assessment, Periodic Evaluation and Accreditation of the Italian University System”, approved by the ANVUR Governing Board on 9 January 2013;
- CONSIDERING** the Guidelines for the implementation of the University’s QA System issued on 2 February 2016, as amended;
- CONSIDERING** the findings expressed by ANVUR in the Final Periodic Accreditation Report on the University and the Programmes regarding the participation of students in the bodies of the University Quality Assurance System approved by the ANVUR Governing Board on 8 March 2017;
- CONSIDERING** the Statute of Autonomy of IULM University (Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM), published in the Gazzetta Ufficiale della Repubblica Italiana no. 59 on 12 March 1998, as amended;
- CONSIDERING** the University’s Academic Regulations, issued by Rector’s Decree no. 11738 on 18 September 2001, as amended;
- CONSIDERING** the electoral regulations, issued by Rector’s Decree no. 12700 on 22 September 2003, as amended, and in particular article 21, paragraph 1;
- CONSIDERING** the decisions taken by the Academic Senate in their meetings on 14 June 2016, 21 March 2017, and 4 April 2018;



CONSIDERING the shared regulatory Protocol for measures to contain and combat COVID-19 adopted by the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM, revised 13 April 2021;

ACKNOWLEDGING that elections for the renewal of student representatives on the various committees for the two-year period 2021/2022 - 2022/2023 will be held on 23 and 24 November 2021;

AWAITING The issuing of the Rectoral Decree appointing the aforementioned representatives;

ACKNOWLEDGING the expiry of the mandate of the Quality Assurance Groups on 23 December 2021 and of the Joint Teaching-Student Committees on 31 December 2021;

CONSIDERING the need to redefine the composition of the Quality Assurance Groups and of the Joint Teaching-Student Committees;

DECREES

Art. 1 - Scope

The University's Quality Assurance System (QA) provides for the participation of students. Their main role is to collaborate in analysing data and information in order to detect critical points and formulate proposals for improvements in the study programmes. To this end, students are expected to participate in the QA Groups for the Courses of Study and in the *Commissioni Paritetiche* (Joint Teaching-Student Committees).

for the period from January 2022 to December 2023 the call for applications is for a total of **30 contracts** as described in the following table:

The students selected will become members of the **QA Groups for the courses of study** or the **Faculty Joint Teaching-Student Committees**, with the assignment being made on the basis of the course of study in which they are enrolled.

Due to the Coronavirus emergency, which does not allow for the definitive planning of the activities covered by this call for applications, the following procedures will be adopted for the implementation of the collaboration, also in relation to the subsequent decisions to be taken by the University regarding the evolution of the pandemic situation: **remote activities**.

In order to carry out these activities, students must have their own PC and an adequate internet connection; connection and telephone costs are not reimbursable. The General Management reserves the right to authorise activities to be carried out in person, should health circumstances permit.

For activities that will be authorised to take place in person, the provisions of the shared Protocol for the regulation of measures to contain and combat COVID-19 set out in the preamble shall be taken into account.

Further information regarding the activities and characteristics of the duties are specified in **Annex A** of this call.

At least 5 hours of initial training on the topics of Quality and Evaluation will be provided by the *Nucleo*



di Valutazione (Independent Evaluation Unit) and the *Presidio della Qualità* (unit responsible for the internal QA system), which the selected students **are obliged to attend**. The training hours are included in the duration of the contract. Details of the main duties to be carried out will be provided during the training course, also in agreement with the student representatives.

Art. 2 – Application procedures

Applications may be submitted by students who are regularly enrolled in 3-year degree courses and Master's degree courses at IULM University, by filling out the form available on the University website at www.iulm.it (in the section “Vivere in IULM – Collaborare con l'Università”) and submitting it before **11 p.m. on 1 December 2021** together with the relevant documentation **in PDF format** to: bandi@iulm.it (confirmation of receipt will be issued). The following documents must be attached to the application:

- curriculum vitae;
- photocopy of a valid ID document.

Art. 3 – Selection procedure

Selection will be made on the basis of rankings determined by the scoring method described in Annex B. The interviews, which candidates are obliged to attend (failure to attend will result in exclusion from the rankings), will be held online in **December 2021** by, respectively, the Coordinators for the courses of study (or their delegates) for the QA Groups, and by the Chairpersons of the Joint Committees (or their delegates) for the Joint Teaching-Student Committees.

The interviews will be held online on the TEAMS platform. The dates and times of the interviews will be announced on the website.

This call for applications constitutes an invitation for admission to the selection interview, after verification of the requirements by the University Offices.

Applicants must be available at the institutional IULM e-mail account (@studenti.iulm.it) specified in the application, on the day and time set for the interview. For the purpose of identification and under penalty of exclusion, each candidate must, before the interview begins, identify him/herself by showing the same identity document already submitted as an attachment to the application.

The candidate may be excluded if he/she has not indicated the institutional e-mail address, if he/she is not connected, if he/she is unavailable on the day or at the time established, or if he/she does not show a valid identity document.

IULM University declines all responsibility in the event that technical reasons prevent regular procedures from being followed when carrying out the interview.

In the event of the renunciation or the exclusion of a candidate, the contract may be awarded to the first eligible candidate in the rankings (for the remaining hours).

Art. 4 – Execution of duties

Duties will be carried out **from the signing of the deed of commitment to 31st December 2023** and will cover both lesson periods and examination periods.

Students must guarantee availability regarding times in accordance with the instructions received from the Coordinator of the course of study/Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-Student Committee, also in



relation to the specific requirements of the individual degree courses.

The students selected will participate in the QA process for the courses of study and will be called upon to carry out data analyses and support activities for the preparation of documents. In addition, the students will be required to gather observations and suggestions from students following the related course of study, also through twice-yearly meetings organized for sharing and exchanging ideas.

At the end of the period of service, prior to the expiry of the contract, students must write a short report (between 400 and 700 words) to be sent to the following address: presidio.qualita@iulm.it.

Art. 5 – Forfeiture

In the case of termination of student status (for example, in the event of **failure to complete enrolment, failure to renew enrolment for the following year, withdrawal from university studies, transfer to another university or attainment of the degree**), the contract will be terminated by the Joint Committees or by the QA Groups with the consequent obligation to notify the Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-Student Committee (for students belonging to the Joint Committees), or the Coordinator of the course of study (for students belonging to the QA Groups) and the *Presidio della Qualità*.

Likewise, students are required to renounce the contract in the event of prolonged absences (e.g. **periods of study abroad or internships**) that do not allow them to carry out the assigned activities in a regular manner, unless agreed in writing directly with the QA Management Group and with the *Presidio della Qualità* (for students belonging to the QA Groups), and with the Chairperson of the Joint Committee (for students belonging to the Joint Committees).

In the case where students obtain their 1st level degree during the mandate - only for those who graduate in the July and November sessions - and then enrol, without interrupting their studies, in one of IULM University's Master's degree courses in the academic year following the one in which they obtained their 1st level degree, after hearing the Course Coordinator (or his/her delegate) for the QA Groups and the Chairperson of the Joint Committee (or his/her delegate) for the Joint Teaching-Student Committees, the contracts may be extended until the end of the calendar year to which they refer.

In the event of failure to perform the duties required, as verified by the *Presidio della Qualità*, the QA Group or the Joint Committees, the students may be relieved of their duties.

Halfway through the mandate (December 2022) a review will be carried out prior to confirmation of the appointment for the following year, to be carried out, respectively, by the Coordinator of the Course of Study (or his/her delegate) for the QA Groups, and the Chairperson of the Joint Committee (or his/her delegate) for the Joint Teaching-Student Committees.

Art. 6 – Method of payment

The amount to be paid to students is set at **€ 360.00 net per year** for a fixed total of 40 hours. **Activation of the IULM card is required for the payment of the remuneration.**

If the service is suspended and no subsequent period of service is authorised, no remuneration is due in relation to the period of collaboration not carried out.

If the collaboration starts during the year or ends prematurely, the remuneration shall be equal to the months of service actually served.

The payment will be made by the University Administration on receiving certification of the activity carried out, countersigned by the Coordinator of the course of study / Chairperson of the Joint Teaching-



Student Committee using the forms provided by the University.

Pursuant to art. 11, paragraph III, of Legislative Decree no. 68 of 29 March 2012, the service requested from the student shall be tax-exempt and does not in any way constitute a permanent employment contract.

The University, if necessary and at its own expense, will provide for insurance against accidents for the students who have been assigned the contracts. The position does not give rise to any obligation for health or pension insurance. The work will not lead to receiving any evaluation for the purposes of participation in public competitive examinations.

Art. 7 - Incompatibility

The awarding of the contracts referred to in this call is without prejudice to the awarding of other benefits by the Right to Study Office.

The contracts referred to in this call are incompatible with participation in the activities of the *Presidio della Qualità*, the Independent Evaluation Unit, the Academic Senate and the Board of Governors.

The remuneration deriving from the contracts referred to in this call cannot be combined with the benefits referred to in art. 12, paragraph III of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001 (University scholarships and scholarships to promote special projects for international mobility for study or training purposes, also regarding eligibility for the Master's degree thesis) announced by IULM University.

- on completion of their contract, write a short report (400-700 words) to be submitted to the *Presidio della qualità*.

1. DATA PROCESSORS

The **data controller** is the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM, located in Via Carlo Bo, 1, Milan and represented by its *pro-tempore* legal representative.

2. DATA PROCESSED

In order to allow the interview to take place via online streaming, in addition to personal data and contact details, the candidates' image and voice will also be processed using their webcam. The image and voice will not be recorded or broadcast in any way. Candidates will be asked to show their identity document during streaming for the sole purpose of allowing the University to recognise them.

3. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING AND LAWFUL BASIS

The personal data provided will be processed in accordance with the conditions of lawful basis pursuant to article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 for the following purposes:

- online interview;
- identification of the candidate;
- verification that the requirements for participation in the selection procedure are met and that there are no grounds for exclusion;
- management of the selection procedure, at all stages, including publication of results and rankings.

4. RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF DATA

Since the test will take place via live streaming, the images and voices of the candidates will not be recorded in any way, nor stored by the University and will not be disseminated in any way.

Personal data relating to personal details and data relating to rankings or records will be stored indefinitely, also for historical interest, in accordance with the archiving obligations laid down by current legislation (Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, Prime Ministerial Decree of 3 December 2013).

The documents containing the results and the rankings will be published on the University website for a maximum period of 3 months.

7. NATURE OF THE CONFERMENT AND REFUSAL

The provision of personal data for the purposes set out in point 3 of this policy document is **necessary** in order to manage the activities described above in connection with the selection process. **Failure to agree to providing the personal data will make it impossible to manage all the activities referred to in point 3.**

8. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS
