


SEMESTER STEPS

Select your courses

- Check the courses available on the updated Course Catalogue or at iulm.it/it/ myiulm/corsi. You can select courses from different degrees (both Bachelor's and Master's) and different years of study, according to your language certification. Please always check the number of credits, the professor(s) name(s), and the semester.
- Check the courses' timetable at <u>aule.iulm.it/Orario</u>.
- Check your course selection with your home university before confirming it to the IULM Study Abroad Office. After the official registration, no changes are possible.
- You will receive by email the link to fill out the **Course Registration Form (CRF)** to select all the courses you want to enroll in. Be sure you fill out all the required fields, as uncompleted forms will not be processed. **Please note that if you do not include a course in your list, you won't be able to take the exam**. CRF's deadlines will be communicated accordingly before the semester starts.





Register for the exams

- The **exam schedules** will be available around one month and a half before the start of the exam session. You have to register online for each exam on your Online Services profile. **If you don't register for the call(s), you won't be able to take the exam.**
- The **registration** period for any exam is from 30 days until 3 days before the exam.
- For language exams of SSML Carlo Bo's courses, registration modalities will be communicated later in the semester.
- Only for ILC exams, the registration period is from 30 days until 5 days before the call.
- Further information about exam registration will be given during an Exam Registration Meeting later in the semester.

Take the exams

You should study for each exam according to the guidelines and bibliography of the online course descriptions, following the instructions given by the lecturer(s) during classes. Information about the course and exam contents, programs, and materials can be found in the Course Catalogue (click on their links in column J). Please organize your stay at IULM considering the last day of the exam session. When booking your flights home, be aware that it's not possible to take exams online.

After the exams

The Study Abroad Office will prepare the **final Transcript of Records** and send it to you and your Home University. Only the exams passed with a mark between 18/30 and 30/30 will be listed on the Transcript of Records. You will receive the ToR by email within 30 days after the end of the exam session.



COURSE SELECTION

Attendance

For most courses, attendance is not compulsory. However, we strongly recommend attending classes so that you can make the most of your mobility experience and also receive all the information about study materials and exam modalities.

Admission

You can select courses from different degrees and different years of study, according to your language certification and semester of mobility, for up to 30 credits per semester.

Restriction

- To attend some specific **2-year Master's degree courses, capped courses** (with limited places available), or courses with special prerequisites, students need confirmation from the Study Abroad Office.
- Undergraduate incoming students are admitted to Master's courses only upon acceptance by the Study Abroad Office, except for 1-year courses from Englishtaught Master's degrees.
- The **language laboratories** from the Bachelor's and Master's degrees of the Faculty of Interpreting and Translation are held at SSML "Carlo Bo" and can be selected only by students attending a degree course in foreign languages and translation in their home university.
- Language courses taught by the **International Language Center (ILC)** have specific rules. For more information about these courses and corresponding requisites, ask directly to the Study Abroad Office.





ERASMUS+ STUDENTS

Certificate of Arrival - Departure - Attendance

Your university will ask you to complete a certificate that proves the official dates of your mobility period. Ask for the document from your university, and then hand it out in our office on the day of your arrival and right before your departure.

We will certify only the effective days of your mobility until the semester ends, and not more if you decide to stay in Milan longer after the exam session is over.

Learning Agreement

Some European universities are connected with the EWP Dashboard to sign Online Learning Agreements (OLA) electronically.

Check with your home university and fill out your OLA at this link: learning-agreement.eu

If your university doesn't use EWP, please send us your LA by email or hand it out in paper version at our office.

NON-EU STUDENTS

Entry VISA

You must apply for an entry VISA for study purposes at the Italian Embassy or Consulate of your own country. It may take more than a month to complete the visa process, so we recommend you start the procedure as soon as possible.

If you are requesting a visa for studying in Italy, you have to pre-register on the **Universitaly** platform. Once you register in the Universitaly portal, you can apply for your visa for study.

Permit of Stay

The Permit of stay is the document required for non-EU nationals to validate legal stay in Italy for a fixed period. You must apply for the Residence Permit within eight working days of your arrival in Italy. You can pick up the yellow application kit at the Study Abroad Office.

Private Health Insurance

To submit the request for the Permit of Stay, you must subscribe to private health insurance which covers the whole mobility period in Italy. IULM University has an agreement with the insurance company AON for health or complete insurance. If you don't have private insurance on arrival in Italy you can contact AON.

ALL STUDENTS

Tax Code

All incoming students must get an Italian Tax Code called *Codice Fiscale*. This code made of letters and numbers identifies a person in public administration forms, private contracts, and money transfers. It is free to obtain and valid for a lifetime.

If you didn't request your Tax Code at the Consular services office before arriving in Italy, you can do it once you arrive in Milan. It can be requested at the nearest Revenue Agency Office only upon appointment or by sending an application form by email.

Transcript of Records

At the end of your mobility, you will receive an official Transcript of Records with all the marks of the exams you passed. It will be sent by email to you and your university in copy.

We will start issuing all students' ToR after the end of the exam session, and you will receive it within 30 days from the last day of the session.

Online Student Services (Sportello Segreteria Online)

Go to https://servizionline.iulm.it/Home.do to access the Online Student Services. Click on Menu, then log in with your username and password. Through this page, you can verify your study plan, register for an exam, and see your exam results.

Institutional email address

Add your IULM email address to your Google accounts.

Connect to mail.studenti.iulm.it and enter your username and password. The first time, authorize by clicking on "Yes, continue", and then add this mailbox to the list of your Google accounts.

IULM Community

Go to https://community.iulm.it and access with your username and password to check information and materials about your selected courses, articles, lecture slides, and messages from the professors.

Libraccio bookshop

The **Libraccio bookshop** is located outside IULM 1, next to the bank. You can buy new and second-hand books, university books, school materials and gadgets.

Printing Centre

At **IULM PRINT** (IULM 3, ground floor – next to the Canteen) you can pay for photocopying, printing and scanning papers, documents and study materials

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
