

- **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR COMPILING YOUR STUDY PLAN – ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/21 – MASTER’S DEGREE COURSES**
- **first year** students can compile their study plan and enter the OPTIONAL teaching activities for a maximum of 18 CFU credits on the dates set out for the academic year 2020/21. The optional courses can be chosen not only from the degree course you are actually following (which would be preferable), but also from other Master’s degree courses activated for any course year. Students enrolled in the first year of the Master’s degree courses in HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT; ART, VALORISATION AND MARKET; CONFERENCE INTERPRETING do **NOT** have to compile a study plan for the first year of the course;
- **second year** students must compile their study plan on the dates set out for the academic year 2020/21, for a maximum of 18 CFU credits. The optional courses can be chosen not only from the degree course you are actually following (which would be preferable), but also from other Master’s degree courses activated for any course year.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR COMPILING YOUR STUDY PLAN – ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/21 - “FUORI CORSO” STUDENTS ON MASTER’S DEGREE COURSES

Students enrolling “fuori corso” for the academic year 2020/2021 and who have to modify their study plan **must be duly enrolled for the academic year 2020/2021** and therefore pay the “fuori corso” enrolment fee in advance.

First year “fuori corso”: it is possible to select courses worth from 6 to 12 CFU credits chosen from all the optional courses activated for the academic year 2020/2021.

From the second year “fuori corso”: you must be duly enrolled for the academic year 2020/21. For modification requests write to pianodistudio@iulm.it.
