

EXEMPTION FROM ILC FOREIGN LANGUAGE EXAMS - STUDENTS ENROLLED IN ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 AND FOLLOWING YEARS

The Boards of the Faculty of Communication and the Faculty of Arts, Fashion and Tourism, on 13 October 2025, deliberated on granting exemptions from the foreign language exams for courses organised by the International Language Centre for students with the following certification, obtained no earlier than 1st January two years prior to the academic year of enrolment*:

Please note that:

- students who attended and graduated from an English-speaking secondary school, either in Italy or abroad, are exempt from the English for Corporate Skills exam;
- students holding a high school diploma equivalent to the Italian qualification obtained in a country where French, Spanish or German is an official language, or obtained at an institute where the language of instruction is the same as the chosen language, are exempt from the **second language** exams.

^{*} For example: for students enrolling in the academic year 2026/2027, certification must have been obtained after 1st January 2024.
