# 1 – COMPOSITION AND NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

## 1.1 The University Scholarship

The University Scholarship is a financial benefit granted as an incentive for academic merit. For tax purposes, it is treated as income equivalent to employment income. Scholarship recipients will receive appropriate tax certification from the University for the amounts paid, as these are subject to personal income tax.

The scholarship referred to in this Call excludes any additional welfare or social security benefits and does not constitute any kind of employment or contractual relationship with the University

## 1.2 Amount of the University Scholarship

The amount of the University Scholarship for the academic year 2025/2026 is **€2,000.00** gross.

Within the limits of the allocated budget, amounting to €100,000.00 (one hundred thousand euros), 50 scholarships will be awarded.

**The distribution of the Scholarships takes into account the number of students enrolled in each year of each Bachelor's and Master's degree programme.**

## 2 – GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR SELECTION

### 2.1 Programme levels

The programme levels for which the University Scholarship is available are:

- Bachelor's degree programmes (three-year, first-cycle degree)
- Master's degree programmes (two-year, second-cycle degree)

### 2.2 Selection of Eligible Candidates

Italian students, students from Member States of the European Union, and international students referred to in Presidential Decree No. 394 of 31 August 1999, implementing Legislative Decree No. 286 of 25 July 1998, may be considered for selection.

Students must be enrolled in a regular year of a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme; students enrolled beyond the standard duration of the programme ("fuori corso") are therefore excluded.

In order to be considered for the award of a University Scholarship, students must meet the requirements set out in Section 3.

## 3 – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

In order to be considered for the award of a University Scholarship, students must meet the following requirements:

- Students must be fully up to date with the payment of tuition fees and related charges due for the academic year 2025/2026;
- In the academic year 2025/2026, students must not be recipients or eligible non-recipients for the same year of study of a regional scholarship or any equivalent financial support, in any form, granted by other public or private bodies;
- In the academic year 2025/2026, students must not have been granted a total or partial tuition fee waiver, for any reason, for the same academic year.

## 4 – RANKING LISTS

Ranking lists will be drawn up by degree programme (Bachelor's and Master's) and by year of study.

Within each ranking list, candidates will be ordered in descending order according to the number of university credits earned by the first examination session of the academic year 2025/2026. Only fully passed examinations will be taken into account; therefore, individual modules or partial components of modular courses will not be considered. In the event of a tie in the number of credits, ranking will be determined by the weighted average grade of examinations, which in any case must not be lower than 27/30

For newly enrolled students in Bachelor's or Master's degree programmes, where both the number of credits and the weighted average grade are equal, priority will be given to the student with the higher secondary school leaving examination grade ("maturità") or previous degree grade.

Where there is still a tie in the number of credits, weighted average grade and—where applicable—the secondary school or degree grade (for newly enrolled students only), priority will be given to the student whose family economic situation is less favourable, as determined by the ISEE indicator in accordance with the University Regulations on Fees and Contributions for the academic year 2025/2026.

In the event of a further tie, the younger student will be given priority.

The examinations considered valid for the purposes of the ranking lists are those specifically included in the study plan established by the Faculty. Examinations graded on scales other than the thirty-point scale may also be considered valid.

Credits obtained from remedial educational obligations and from individual modules will not be taken into account **(partial examinations and/or modules will not be considered, even if officially recorded)**.

## 5 – COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS

The results of the scholarship allocation will be communicated to the interested students by email **by 27 April 2026**.

## 6 – AWARD AND PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships will be awarded until the maximum number established in this Call has been reached.

Students who are selected as recipients will be contacted by the Fees, Grants and Scholarships Office in order to sign the acceptance form for the award.

Payment of the scholarship amount will primarily be made through credit to the "Card Ateneo Più", issued by Banca Popolare di Sondrio to all students enrolled at IULM University.

Students are required to enter their bank details (IBAN) in the relevant section of the "SPORTELLO Diritto allo studio" online portal.

In accordance with the provisions of Reg. (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) we hereby provide you with the necessary information regarding the processing of the personal data provided. This policy has been drawn up pursuant to article 13 of Reg. (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and is also inspired by the provisions of Directive 2002/58/CE, as updated by [Directive 2009/136/CE](#), regarding Cookies, as well as the Provisions of the Italian Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data of 08.05.2014 regarding cookies.

### 1. DATA PROCESSORS

The DATA CONTROLLER, pursuant to Articles 4 and 24 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 is the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM located in Via Carlo Bo, 1 - 20143 Milano, represented by its pro-tempore legal representative.

### 2. PURPOSES OF PROCESSING AND LAWFUL BASIS

The personal data will be processed in accordance with the conditions of lawful basis pursuant to article 6 of Reg. (EU) 2016/679 for the following purposes:

Under article 6(e)

-To organize and set up for the students concerned all the financial measures suitable for guaranteeing equal opportunities for accessing the university's structures;

-Management of applications for financial benefits and related administrative and accounting activities, including checks on personal and fiscal details.

Under article 6(b)

-Management of applications to access the University Residences, the assignment of accommodation and related administrative and accounting activities (e.g. invoicing).

Under article 6(a)

-Management of applications for an "extraordinary grant" in the event of a serious situation, where the situation in question concerns the state of health and/or disability of the applicant or of one of the recipients of their family income.

### 3. RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF DATA

The personal data provided may be communicated to recipients, appointed pursuant to article 28 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, who will process the data in their capacity as data processors and/or as natural persons acting under the authority of the Data Controller and Data Processor in order to comply with contracts or related purposes. Precisely, the data may be communicated to recipients belonging to the following categories:

- Designated internal University structures;
- Companies responsible for providing services in the Residences and catering establishments;
- External bodies in order to provide integrated services for university students and with responsibility for promoting the right to study;
- Competent authorities for compliance with legal obligations, upon request;

- Accident insurance companies;
- Entities providing services for the management of the information system and communication networks of the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM (including e-mail and the IULM web platform).

The subjects belonging to the above categories are responsible for the processing of data, or operate in total autonomy as separate data controllers. The list of designated data processors is constantly updated and available from the Libera Università di Lingue e Comunicazione IULM.

#### **4. DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRIES AND/OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS**

Personal data will not be transferred abroad within or outside the European Union.

#### **5. PERIODS OF DATA STORAGE OR CRITERIA**

The processing will be carried out automatically and/or manually, with methods and tools designed to ensure maximum security and confidentiality, by persons specifically appointed for this purpose. In compliance with the provisions of art. 5, paragraph 1(e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the personal data collected will be kept in a form that allows the identification of the data subject for a period of time not exceeding the completion of the purposes for which the personal data are processed. In particular, the students' personal data and university study data are kept by the University indefinitely, the retention of the remaining data is based on the storage period of the administrative acts that contain them

#### **6. NATURE OF THE CONFERMENT AND REFUSAL**

The provision of the personal data for the purposes referred to in point 2 of this privacy policy is necessary to manage the activities described above, related to the assignment of benefits, financial aid, services and university accommodation upon request. Failure to agree to provide the personal data will make it impossible to manage all the activities referred to in point 2 of this privacy policy.

#### **7. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS**

Students may exercise their rights in accordance with the provisions set out in articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 by , by contacting the Data Controller, or the Data Protection Officer or the DPO service by email at [privacy@iulm.it](mailto:privacy@iulm.it)

Students have the right at any time to ask the Data Controller for access to their personal data, and also exercise their rights regarding the rectification, deletion and purpose limitation of the processing. Furthermore, they have the right at any time to oppose the processing of their data (including automated processing, such as profiling) and the portability of their data. Without prejudice to any other administrative or jurisdictional appeal, should the data subject believe that the processing of their data violates the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, pursuant to Article 15 letter f) of the aforementioned Regulation (EU) 2016/679, it is possible to make a complaint to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data and, with reference to Article 6 paragraph 1, letter a) and Article 9 paragraph 2, letter a), it is possible to revoke the consent given at any time.

In the case of a request for data portability, the Data Controller will provide the personal data from an automatic device in a structured format which is legible and in common use, without prejudice to paragraphs 3 and 4 of Article 20 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679.
